Remember!

Social structure means what place in society a person holds. For example Egypt had Pharaohs, Slaves and Scribes who all had different rights and different levels of wealth.

Use the words provided to create Ancient China and our modern social structures. Use the ladder for China and the pyramid for Canada. **More than one word** can fit into the ladder and into the pyramid

- 1. Split the word up into two groups, words for Canada and words for China.
- 2. Place words in the social class in the ladder for China.
- 3. Place the words for Canada in the pyramid.
- 4. Keep in mind that the goal is not to MATCH Chinese social structure to Canada's as they are different!
